Announcements

- Next closed EHOPAC meeting will be Tuesday, May 12th. This is for voting members only. There will not be a live EHOPAC meeting at this year's symposium. Experience shows that the audio and IT challenges can be overwhelming as you don't have control over the systems at a hotel. The COF organizers were sensitive about the PACs meeting during symposium time. We looked at a local hotel, but we are back to the audio/IT issue plus the cost of renting a facility. We considered going to CDC but transporting officers to a remote location and back is another logistical obstacle. Lastly, it was observed that the meeting discussion was redundant to the CPO and Chair's report. Based on the collective wisdom of the leadership team, we decided to not hold a PAC meeting at COF. Notable news/activities/accomplishments since last EHOPAC meeting:

- Board Clears 41 EHO Applicants Appointment boards met in April, May, June, July, and October to clear and rank EHO general duty applicants. During this process, the boards have cleared 41 officers for general duty thus far. Out of the 41 boarded EHOs, there are 13 available for hire; 19 have either secured positions or have pending 1662s; 7 have been medically disqualified, and 2 individuals have taken a non-USPHS job. We have sent this list of applicants to the POCs on the securing your first assignment brochure, liaisons and specific hiring managers. We have been helping to answer questions the applicants have by reaching out to appropriate agency contacts and liaisons, and EHOPAC leadership. Five applicants who need positions have a board date of April 30th, will no longer be viable candidates if a position isn't secured by April 30th.
- EHOPAC Coin Design Contest
 - o Iconic, but not too specific to sub-disciplines within the environmental health category;
 - o Include the PHS insignia on one side;
 - o Symbolize the work that we do:
 - o Be legible when printed on a normal sized challenge coin;

- <u>General Active Duty Open Application Window</u> The general active duty open application window is now open for all individuals who have completed a

JRCOSTEP since 2011. There is not a defined closing period yet. Interested applicants need to start by calling the PHS Call Center. The PHS Call Center phone number is 800-279-1605 and details are on the USPHS website at: http://www.usphs.gov/apply/apply.aspx. All applicants must meet the degree requirements for the category that they are applying for in order to be eligible.

- 2015 JRCOSTEP Open Application Window The JRCOSTEP open application window has closed. There were 56 EHO applications and more than 20 students have been tentatively selected by agencies. DCCPR is working on the HHS nomination list and the medical and security clearances. 1662s need to get to DCCPR at least 60 days prior to the student's start date.
- The M&R Subcommittee has been re-organized Moving forward, the IT workgroup will now be under the new Communications Workgroup and the Adopta-School and AOWR Workgroups will combine to meet all future recruitment efforts. This will allow us to be more efficient and serve the EHOPAC in a more timely way. This transition will also assist in removing any duplication between subcommittees and workgroups. The new combined work group is called RAE-Recruit An EHO.




